## Academics

**9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades** – We expect to see at least 3% of our students in each tier move to the next tier this year as indicated by Fall and Spring Scantron data in reading and math. Furthermore, we expect to see continued growth in 100% of our students! Stay tuned to our website for more information on how all stakeholders will be involved in the process!

**11<sup>th</sup> grade** – We expect to see at least 2% growth in the number of our juniors scoring proficient in the reading and math sections of the ACT. The 2% growth will be measured using the Pre-ACT as our baseline.

**12<sup>th</sup> grade** - Senior CCR data will improve by at least 2% from current data by May of 2022. (e.g., grow from 68% to 70%). Any senior attaining a CCR indicator will receive a purple cord for graduation!

**Tutoring** -Before and after school tutoring and Pirate period will be utilized in our system of processes to ensure we are continually moving toward our goals. Before and after school tutoring and Pirate period will feature math, reading, and ACT help. Students selected for tutoring will attend sessions each week (morning group from 6:30-7:30 and afternoon group from 3:00-4:00). 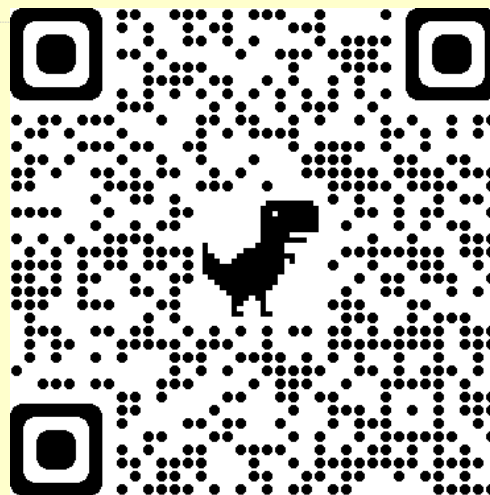

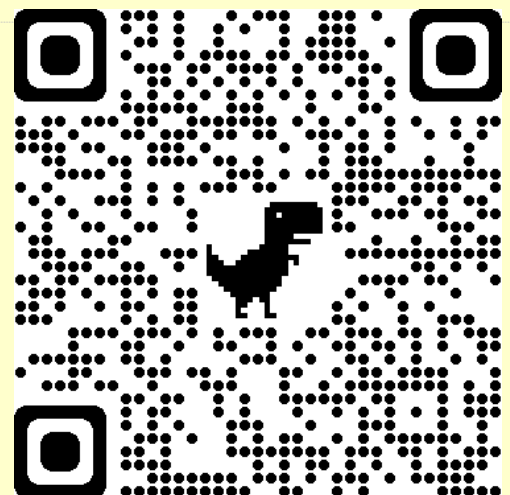
